



Please read and initial next to each statement below indicating that you understand and agree to these conditions of enrollment in the UC Berkeley Extension Berkeley Global Access (BGA) Program:

I understand and agree that:

- _____ If accepted into the BGA Program, I will be admitted as a student of UC Berkeley Extension and NOT of the University of California, Berkeley.
- _____ I will receive a UC Berkeley Cal 1 student ID card, which looks similar to the card matriculated students will receive, but with limited access to some resource on campus. I will still be considered a UC Berkeley Extension student for enrollment purposes.
- _____ Acceptance into BGA does not guarantee enrollment into any specific course or department. Enrollment for BGA students is on a space-available basis.
- _____ BGA students must enroll in at least a full-time load of classes (12 units) as required by UC Berkeley Extension policy and U.S. immigration law for students who enter the U.S. on an F-1 student visa.
- _____ BGA students may enroll in a maximum of 18 units (UC Berkeley campus + Extension courses). BGA Students are required to enroll in at least 2 units of UC Berkeley Extension courses. BGA does have 1 unit Extension courses, and I understand I must enroll in more than one course if I enroll in a 1 unit course. If BGA students subsequently enroll in additional UC Berkeley Extension courses (either by choice or lack of availability of UC Berkeley Campus courses), no adjustment or refund of the initial program fee will be granted.
- _____ Matriculated UC Berkeley undergraduate and graduate students receive priority enrollment in UC Berkeley campus courses.
- _____ There is no advance enrollment in UC Berkeley campus courses for BGA students. BGA students may not seek instructor/departmental approval until the first day of UC Berkeley campus courses each semester, and most BGA students' schedules will likely not be finalized until *at least* the second week of classes.
- _____ Course enrollment for BGA students requires that all prerequisites have been met. Enrollment also requires instructor and possibly departmental approval.
- _____ BGA students have limited access to UC Berkeley campus courses in business, computer science, economics, engineering, mathematics, physics, and information. These departments may also require a supplemental application during the enrollment process.
- _____ BGA students may not enroll in any UC Berkeley School of Law courses.
- _____ I will remain patient and flexible during the enrollment process and will submit numerous options in the Concurrent Enrollment Application system during the course registration period.
- _____ BGA students may enroll in graduate-level courses only with both the approval of the BGA program and instructor/departmental approval. If approved, it is recommended that BGA students take no more than ONE graduate level course.
- _____ Grades & units earned in UC Berkeley Extension & UC Berkeley campus courses will be posted to an official transcript issued by UC Berkeley Extension. UC Berkeley Extension courses will be denoted by an "X" and UC Berkeley campus course by an "XB" next to the course number.
- _____ I am responsible for verifying acceptability of UC Berkeley Extension units in advance of my registration through consultation with my home university.
